

Glass Ornaments Offered by Nippo

Nippo Corporation is proud to present premium quality glass ornaments with a unique design. They are 100% hand-made by European craftsmen using the finest materials, and have been manufactured for centuries. The ornaments are mouth-blown and hand-painted according to a tradition passed on through generations of artisans.

How are our ornaments made?

A craftsman gathers molten sodium glass from the furnace on the end of a blowing iron, blowing into the end of the tube and rotating the iron to produce an even spherical shape. The glass is formed into a basic bubble, which can subsequently be turned into an infinite range of shapes and forms by further blowing or slumping the glass into a mould. The next stage is silver coating and/or hand painting of the pattern on the glass surface. Each artist gives a unique touch of his or her imagination and creativity to the ornaments.

Warm reception in the Asian markets

Originally, such glass ornaments were used for decorating Christmas trees in Europe and America, but in recent years they are gaining more and more popularity as all-year decoration, also among the Asian customers. Glass ornaments come in a multitude of sizes, typically from 60 to 200 mm, shapes varying from balls to trees, angels, cars, locomotives or houses. Their hand-painted patterns and pictures very often constitute independent art works. Our ornaments can be illuminated either from outside or by a candle put inside some of the ornaments that can be used as fairy lamps. You can hang our glass trimmings on your Christmas tree or use a special stand, decorating your living room or working space with an original and stylish art object.
